Classroom, Cafeteria, & Field Trips

- Complete this in-person training
- Fill out the Parent Volunteer Agreement & give completed form to front office
- Background paperwork can be found on the website or at the front desk.
- Wear GCS Polo and pick up your volunteer badge/visitor sticker when you come in to volunteer the first time
 - All adults must wear a sticker/badge during closed gate hours
- All volunteers (except lunch and art) begin after Labor Day



Classroom, Cafeteria, & Field Trips

Receive custom teacher-designed training when you report to volunteer.

Lunchroom coordinator Randi Dennis will help you learn the ropes in the amazing, joyful cafeteria that she manages!

Classroom Expectations

- Siblings are not permitted.
- Please communicate with the teacher if you're not able to attend.
- At the end of your "shift" please step outside to wait for your child if talking with other adults.

Field Trips

- Must be cleared to drive a van
- Attend training with Ron Miller to get comfortable with bus operation before driving for the first time.
- Submit copy driver's license/insurance/ MVD form
- GCS has you covered while driving for us



Tips for Successful Bus Trips

- Students may not be transported in private cars during school hours unless given permission by school administration.
- Pick up & return vans from the high school.
- Elementary students must wear seat-belts.
- Class must clean up the van.
- Caravan for back-up. Exchange cell numbers with other drivers. No unplanned stops.
- Students may not switch buses or vans. They have assigned seats for safety.
- In case of emergency get the children safely off the bus and call 911.
