



International Student Admission Process

(*Please note: We only accept students entering Grades 9-12, and student must graduate by age 20.)

**All applications must be submitted online at our website at

(Please note that you **MUST** enter "International" as the grade level.)**

1. Complete the application and submit all required documents, including the non-refundable application fee of \$450. (Applications will not be considered until the application fee has been paid.)
2. Have your TOEFL score report (Test of English as a Foreign Language) sent to us directly from the testing center. (Our TOEFL Code is 1980.) We will also accept an IELTS (International English Language Testing System) report (using the General Training test) or an iTEP (International Test of English Proficiency) SLATE-Plus report. We do not accept the SLEP test.

The following scores are required for admission (but may be waived by the Principal under certain circumstances):

TOEFL: minimum score of 50

IELTS: minimum score of 5.5

iTEP SLATE-Plus: minimum score of 4.5

3. Once we have received all documents and the application fee, the application will be reviewed. If they are complete and they fulfill our TOEFL/IELTS/iTEP score requirements, you will be considered for a virtual interview if we have an available spot.
4. If you pass the virtual interview, we will send you a letter of acceptance.
5. When you receive your letter of acceptance, you will need to pay the building fee, the host family fee (if applicable), and at least one semester's tuition.
6. After we have confirmed receiving these funds, we will issue you an I-20 and mail it to you.
7. When you receive your I-20, you will need to go online and pay your SEVIS fee. (Please keep your receipt.)
8. You will then need to make an appointment at the consulate of your country for a Visa interview.
9. You will need a valid passport to take with you to your Visa interview.
10. Once you have been issued a Visa, you can then enter the United States to attend our school.
