



COLLEGE PLANNING TIMELINE

JUNIOR YEAR

- Keep your focus on achieving strong grades and develop relationships with your teachers.
- Learn to read your school and personal emails daily and respond as necessary.
- Create a paper file to hold any documents related to report cards, receipts, dual enrollment, test scores, etc.
- Touch base with your Counselor often.
- Consider dual enrollment registration if you are enrolled in the appropriate classes.
- Plan to take the ACT or SAT by the spring of junior year. You can register at act.org or collegeboard.org
- Take the PSAT with your best effort. The test is proctored on campus in October.
- Research possible careers. Research majors related to desired careers.
- Attend the Christian College Fair, on campus, in October. Attend local college fairs.
- Research fall/spring programs such as tours, weekend stays and orientations hosted by schools that interest you. Reach out to admissions counselors.
- Schedule college visits. Make sure to submit the College Visit form (found in the front office).
- Athletes get cleared by NAIA and NCAA.
- Ensure your social media accounts are clean.
- Attend “Rising Senior Night” in the spring.
- Look for volunteer/leadership opportunities.
- Research summer jobs, internships or camps.
